Information for Prospective Franchisees Required by Federal Trade Commission

To protect you, we've required your franchisor to give you this information. We haven't checked it, and don't know if it's correct. It should help you make up your mind. Study it carefully. While it includes some information about your contract, don't rely on it alone to understand your contract. Read all of your contract carefully. Buying a franchise is a complicated investment. Take your time to decide. If possible, show your contract and this information to an advisor, like a lawyer or an accountant. If you find anything you think may be wrong or anything important that's been left out, you should let us know about it. It may be against the law.

There may also be laws on franchising in your state. Ask your state agencies about them.

The franchisee will operate a quick service restaurant under the name "Hardee's 6"Hardee's Restaurant") or a quick service restaurant under the names "Hardee's" and "Red Burrito" ("Dust Gomept Restaurant"). The franchise described in this offering circular is offered only to existing Hardee's franchisees who meet the criteria described in Item 1.

The initial franchise fee for a Hardee's Restaurant ranges from \$10,000 to \$35,000. The estimated initial investment for a newly developed Hardee's Restaurant ranges from approximately \$820,800 to \$1,177,500. This does not include the cost of buying or renting the business location.

The initial franchise fee for a Dual Concept Restaurant ranges from \$15,000 to \$47,500 for a newly developed Dual Concept Restaurant and from \$5,000 to \$12,500 for a Dual Concept Restaurant converted from an existing Hardee's Restaurant. If you are converting an existing Hardee's Restaurant to a Dual Concept Restaurant, the estimated initial investment ranges from \$66,300 to \$129,800. If you are developing a new Dual Concept Restaurant, the estimated initial investment ranges from \$863,300 to \$1,257,700. These sums do not include the cost of buying or renting the business location.

## Risk Factors:

- 1. THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENTS REQUIRE THAT ALL DISAGREEMENTS BE ARBITRATED ONLY WHERE THE PRINCIPAL OFFICES OF HARDEE'S FOOD SYSTEMS, INC. ARE LOCATED, WHICH CURRENTLY IS MISSOURI. OUT OF STATE ARBITRATION MAY FORCE YOU TO ACCEPT A LESS FAVORABLE SETTLEMENT FOR DISPUTES. IT ALSO MAY COST YOU MORE TO ARBITRATE IN MISSOURI, INSTEAD OF YOUR HOME STATE.
- 2. THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENTS STATE THAT MISSOURI LAW GOVERNS THE AGREEMENTS AND THIS LAW MAY NOT PROVIDE THE SAME PROTECTIONS AND BENEFITS AS LOCAL LAW. YOU MAY WANT TO COMPARE THESE LAWS.
- THERE MAY BE OTHER RISKS CONCERNING THIS FRANCHISE.
