The total investment necessary to begin operation of a HiromaruTM Restaurant is between \$194,600 to \$549,600 This includes from \$35,100 to \$60 100 that must be paid to the franchisor or its affiliates. The total investment necessary to begin operation of a HiromaruTM Multi-Unit business is between \$204,600 and \$569,600. This includes between \$45,100 and \$70,100 that must be paid to the franchisor or its affiliates.
