The franchise offered is for an "HOT DOG ON A STICK" restaurant, specializing in fresh-squeezed lemonade, hot dogs on a stick (a 100% turkey dog, dipped in batter and fried to a golden brown), french fries, and complementary products

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a new franchised **HOT DOG ON A STICK** restaurant ranges from \$250,000 to \$649,100. This includes \$0 to \$50,000 that must be paid to the franchisor or its affiliates. If you purchase an existing (operating) restaurant from us, your investment may be higher, in an amount we cannot predict.

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. **Note, however, that no governmental agency has verified the information contained in this document.**
