House of Bread bakery café is a corporation with principal business address of 299 Marsh St., San Luis Obsipo, California 93401. Telephone is 805.542.0255 and email address is bread@houseofbread.com.

The business trademark is the name House of Bread.

The franchisee will operate a specialty bread bakery cafe offering healthy, low-fat, and deliciously baked goods and sandwiches.

The total estimated initial investment ranges from \$157,000 to \$347,000 for one unit. This includes the franchsie fee that is paid to the franchisor. The initial franchise fee is \$32,000 for one franchise. HOB does offer a Multi-Unit franchise agreement. The first franchise unit is \$32,000, the second unit is \$16,000 and third unit is \$8,000. The minimum franchise fee for a mulitple unit franchise agreement of two units is \$48,000 and the maximum franchise fee for a mulitple unit franchise agreement of three units is \$56,000.

The disclosure document summarizes certain provicsion of your franhise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calender-days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchsior or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchsie sale.
