The business trademark is the name House of Bread.

The franchisee will operate a specialty bread bakery cafe offering healthy, low-fat, and deliciously baked goods and sandwiches.

The total estimated initial investment ranges from \$157,000 to \$347,000 for one unit. This includes the franchise fee that is paid to the franchisor. The initial franchise fee is \$35,000 for one franchise. HOB does offer a Multi-Unit franchise agreement. The first franchise unit is \$35,000, the second unit is \$17,500 and third through the eighth unit is \$10,000. The minimum franchise fee for a multiple unit franchise agreement of two units is \$52,500 and the maximum franchise fee for a multiple unit franchise agreement of eight units is \$112,500.

The disclosure document summarizes certain provision of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar-days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. **Note, however, than no governmental agency has verified the information contained in this document.**

The terms of your contract will govern your franchise relationship. Don't rely on the disclosure document alone to understand your contract. Read all of your contract carefully. Show your contract and this disclosure document to an advisor, such as a lawyer and/or an accountant.
