(a Delaware Limited Liability Company)
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HRG Affiliates LLC, a Delaware limited liability company, is offering affiliate relationships to established providers of travel services for network access to corporate travel and related services.

The total investment necessary to begin operation of an HRG Affiliates franchise ranges from \$35,500 to \$60,215. This includes the annual fee for the first contract year of \$35,000, which is the initial fee and is payable in four equal installments of \$8750 and which must be paid to HRG Affiliates LLC.

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your Affiliates Program Agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. Note, however, that no governmental agency has verified the information contained in this document.

- 1. THE AFFILIATES PROGRAM AGREEMENT REQUIRES YOU TO RESOLVE DISPUTES WITH US BY ARBITRATION ONLY IN NEW YORK. OUT-OF-STATE ARBITRATION MAY FORCE YOU TO ACCEPT A LESS FAVORABLE SETTLEMENT FOR DISPUTES. IT MAY ALSO COST YOU MORE TO ARBITRATE IN NEW YORK THAN IN YOUR HOME STATE.
- 2. THE AFFILIATES PROGRAM AGREEMENT STATES THAT NEW YORK LAW GOVERNS THE AGREEMENT, AND THIS LAW MAY NOT PROVIDE THE SAME PROTECTION AND BENEFITS AS LOCAL LAW. YOU MAY WANT TO COMPARE THESE LAWS.
- 3. ALL FEES AND/OR PAYMENTS MAY BE REVIEWED ON AN ANNUAL BASIS AND MAY BE ADJUSTED, IN OUR SOLE DISCRETION, UPON 90 DAYS WRITTEN NOTICE TO YOU, PROVIDED THAT THIS NOTICE WILL NOT BE GIVEN EARLIER THAN 33 MONTHS FROM THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF YOUR AGREEMENT.
- 4. THERE MAY BE OTHER RISKS CONCERNING THE AFFILIATES PROGRAM.
- 5. EVEN THOUGH THE AFFILIATES PROGRAM AGREEMENT PROVIDES THAT "HOME STATE" LAW APPLIES, LOCAL LAW MAY SUPERSEDE IT IN YOUR STATE. PLEASE REFER TO ANY STATE SPECIFIC ADDENDUM THAT MAY BE ATTACHED TO THIS DISCLOSURE DOCUMENT FOR DETAILS.
