As a franchisee, you will operate a learning center offering childcare and academic education programs to children ages six (6) weeks to twelve (12) years, along with related products and services, under the name "Ivy Kids Early Learning Center." The Ivy Kids Early Learning Center shall be referred in this Franchise Disclosure Document as the "Learning Center".

The total initial investment necessary to begin operation of a Learning Center franchise from ground up is from \$3,473,000 to \$4,645,000. This includes the initial Franchise Fee of \$60,000 that must be paid to Ivy Kids Systems, LLC as the franchisor. Please see Items 5 and 7 of this Franchise Disclosure Document for additional details.

We may offer to enter into an area development agreement to establish and operate a certain number of Learning Center franchises at specific locations pursuant to individual franchise agreements. The area development fee is described in detail in Item 5 below. Your estimated initial investment will vary based on the number of Learning Centers to be developed.

This Franchise Disclosure Document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this Franchise Disclosure Document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive the Franchise Disclosure Document at least fourteen (14) calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to the Franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. Note, however, that no government agency has verified the information contained in this document.

OUT OF STATE MEDIATION OR LITIGATION MAY FORCE YOU TO ACCEPT A LESS FAVORABLE SETTLEMENT FOR DISPUTES. IT MAY ALSO COST MORE TO MEDIATE OR LITIGATE WITH THE FRANCHISOR IN TEXAS THAN IN YOUR HOME STATE.
- 2. THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT AND AREA DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT STATE THAT THE LAW OF TEXAS GOVERNS THE AGREEMENTS, AND THIS LAW MAY NOT PROVIDE THE SAME PROTECTIONS AND BENEFITS AS LOCAL LAW. YOU MAY WANT TO COMPARE THESE LAWS.
- 3. THERE MAY BE OTHER RISKS CONCERNING THIS FRANCHISE.
