The total investment necessary to begin operation of a JabzKO franchise ranges from \$78,000 to \$130,100. This includes an amount ranging from \$26,700 to \$27,700 that must be paid to us.

You must receive this Disclosure Document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. **Note, however, that no government agency has verified the information contained in this document**.

We pay this person a fee for selling our franchise or referring you to us. You should be sure to do your own investigation of the franchise.
