You will receive the right to operate a Jet-Black® business (or in limited circumstances a Black Dawg Sealcoat® business) offering asphalt services, or a Yellow Dawg Striping® business offering pavement marking services and parking lot line striping.

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a Jet-Black® business is from \$49,06046.060 to \$109,310104.310 for one to two Franchised Territories. This includes \$37,77544.440 to \$62,79558.162 that must be paid to us or our affiliate. The total investment necessary to begin operation of a Yellow Dawg Striping® business is from \$46,00042.525 to \$69,10063.625 for one to two Franchised Territories. This includes \$26,47525.475 to \$33,22532.225 that must be paid to us or our affiliate.

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully.
