As a Jinya Ramen Bar franchisee you will operate a quick serve restaurant outlet providing a variety of ramen (Japanese style noodle) dishes with various types of broth, sushi, rice bowls, Japanese appetizers, specified condiments and ingredients, and other food, beverages and related products The total investment necessary to begin operation of a Jinya Ramen Bar outlet ranges from \$350,000 to \$771,300 This includes from \$45,000 to \$165,000 that must be paid to the franchisor and its affiliates
