

- 1 THE AREA REPRESENTATIVE AGREEMENT REQUIRES YOU TO RESOLVE DISPUTES WITH US BY LITIGATION IN THE COURTS OF NEW JERSEY, OR THE UNITED STATES DISTRICT COURT, DISTRICT OF NEW JERSEY OUT-OF-STATE LITIGATION MAY FORCE YOU TO ACCEPT A LESS FAVORABLE SETTLEMENT FOR DISPUTES IT MAY ALSO COST YOU MORE TO LITIGATE WITH US IN NEW JERSEY THAN IT MAY COST IN YOUR OWN STATE OR AREA
- 2 THE AREA REPRESENTATIVE AGREEMENT STATES THAT NEW JERSEY LAW GOVERNS THE AGREEMENT, AND THIS LAW MAY NOT PROVIDE THE SAME PROTECTIONS AND BENEFITS AS LOCAL LAW YOU MAY WANT TO COMPARE THESE LAWS
