An Area Representative will act as our agent to solicit new franchisees and provide pre-opening and ongoing support to Jomsom franchisees in a defined geographical area. An Area Representative will pay an Initial Fee that will be negotiated between us. The total investment necessary to begin operation as an Area Representative is \$110,500.00 - \$521,200.00. This includes between \$100,000.00 to \$500,000.00 that must be paid to the franchisor and/or its affiliate.

This Disclosure Document summarizes certain provisions of your Area Representative Agreement and other information in plain English. Read this Disclosure Document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this Disclosure Document at least (14) calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, Jomsom or an affiliate. **Note, however, that no governmental agency has verified the information contained in this document.**

Buying a franchise is a complex investment. The information in this Disclosure Document can help you make up your mind as to whether you wish to become an Area Representative.
