The licensee will operate a KFC unit which prepares and sells chicken, snackables and other approved menu items using certain trademarks and trade secrets owned by KFC Corporation.

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a KFC unit ranges from \$127,500 to \$542,000. This includes \$10,000 to \$31,500 that must be paid to the licensor or its affiliates.

This disclosure document summarizes provisions of your license agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the licensor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed license sale. **Note, however, that no government agency has verified the information contained in this document.**
