Kidcreate Studio businesses operate children's art studios in a class, camp, and party format that focus on art education for children from ages 18 months through 12 years ("<u>Kidcreate Studio</u> <u>Business(es)</u>").

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a Kidcreate Studio franchise ranges from \$92,800 to \$198,500. This includes between \$51,500 and \$91,500 that must be paid to the franchisor or its affiliates.

- 3. WE ARE A NEWLY FORMED COMPANY WITH LIMITED OPERATING HISTORY TO ASSIST YOU IN MAKING THIS INVESTMENT.
- 4. WE HAVE LIMITED FINANCIAL RESOURCES WHICH MIGHT NOT BE ADEQUATE TO FUND OUR PRE-OPENING OBLIGATIONS AND PAY OUR OPERATING EXPENSES.
- 5. THERE MAY BE OTHER RISKS CONCERNING THIS FRANCHISE.
