The franchise being offered is to establish and operate a Max's restaurant. A Max's restaurant is a restaurant and bar that serves a large variety of America's favorite foods (including delicatessen food) in substantial portions with an upscale style, piano bar entertainment, and food festivals.

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a Max's restaurant is \$2,088,500 to \$2,255,000. An initial fee of \$75,000 must be paid to us or our affiliate.

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. The terms of your contract will govern your franchise relationship. Don't rely on the disclosure document alone to understand your contact. Read all of your contract carefully. Show your contract and this disclosure document to an advisor, like a lawyer or an accountant.
