The franchise is for a stand-alone, complementary or conversion business that sells, installs and services automatic misting systems to control outdoor flying insects and related products and services ("MosquitoNix Business" or "Business").

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a stand-alone, complementary or conversion MosquitoNix Business for a single Territory ranges from \$23,100 to \$86,600. These totals include an initial franchise fee that ranges from \$10,000 to \$17,500, a \$2,500 initial inventory package and a \$2,500 startup kit to be paid to or purchased from us or our affiliate, FEMO Products, LLC.

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your Franchise Agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. Note, however, that no governmental agency has verified the information contained in this document.
