The total investment necessary to begin operation of a new Nature Republic franchised business ranges from \$898,725 to \$1,410,295, which includes \$20,000 which must be paid to us when you sign the Franchise Agreement for the initial franchise fee. The total investment necessary for an existing Nature Republic licensee to convert to, and begin operation as, a Nature Republic franchised business ranges from \$49,575 to \$211,441, which includes a conversion franchise fee of \$1,000 that must be paid to us when you sign the Franchise Agreement
