You will operate a business selling residential and commercial onsite Information Technology services and sales, as well as other maintenance related services.

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a Nerds-We Can Fix That! ® franchise is \$74,995 This includes an Initial Franchise Fee that must be paid to the franchisor of either \$29,995 for an approximately 75,000-person territory, or \$39,995 for an approximately 150,000-person territory, or \$69,995 for an approximately 200,000 person territory or \$74,995 for a 300,000 or larger territory.

This Disclosure Document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this Disclosure Document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this Disclosure Document at least 14 calendar days before you can sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale.

The terms of your contract will govern your franchise relationship. Don't rely on the Disclosure Document alone to understand your contract. Read your entire contract carefully. Show your contract and this Disclosure Document to an advisor, like a lawyer or accountant, if you have any questions.

Buying a franchise is a complex investment. The information in this Disclosure Document can help you make up your mind.
