The franchise offered is for the operation of a single unit **OFFICE PRIDE**® janitorial service business that sells and performs janitorial services, related services and ancillary goods in office buildings, retail buildings, medical buildings, commercial buildings, churches and other commercial facilities that require routine contract cleaning to create or maintain a clean work environment.

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a single unit **OFFICE PRIDE**® franchise is from \$51,400 to \$100,100. This includes \$29,900 that must be paid to us or our affiliates. If you currently operate a commercial cleaning business you may convert your existing business to an **OFFICE PRIDE**® franchise.

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar-days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. Note, however that no government agency has verified the information contained in this document.

THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT REQUIRES THAT ALL DISAGREEMENTS (EXCEPT FOR THOSE RELATED TO YOUR USE OF OUR TRADEMARKS AFTER THE EXPIRATION OR TERMINATION OF THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT) BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION, LITIGATION OR THROUGH A PROCESS THAT USES CHURCH AND BIBLICAL PRINCIPLES (WHICH FOLLOW THE TEACHINGS OF JESUS CHRIST AND THE KING JAMES BIBLE), BOTH OF WHICH WILL BE HELD IN FLORIDA. OUT OF STATE DISPUTE RESOLUTION MAY FORCE YOU TO ACCEPT A LESS FAVORABLE SETTLEMENT FOR DISPUTES. IT MAY ALSO COST YOU MORE TO RESOLVE A DISPUTE WITH US IN FLORIDA THAN IN YOUR HOME STATE. ALL LEGAL ACTIONS MUST BE BROUGHT IN THE STATE OF FLORIDA.

2. THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT STATES THAT FLORIDA LAW GOVERNS THE AGREEMENT, AND THIS LAW MAY NOT PROVIDE THE SAME PROTECTIONS AND BENEFITS AS LOCAL LAW. YOU MAY WANT TO COMPARE THESE LAWS.

3. IN THE EVENT OF TERMINATION OR NON-RENEWAL, PAYMENTS DUE TO FRANCHISEE IN ANY AMOUNT MAY BE SUSPENDED UNTIL FRANCHISEE HAS FOLLOWED THE METHODS OF OPERATIONS IN FULL.

4. THE SPOUSE OF THE FRANCHISEE OR THE SPOUSE OF ANY OWNER OF A FRANCHISEE MUST SIGN A CONFIDENTIALITY AND NON-COMPETE AGREEMENT.

5. THERE MAY BE OTHER RISKS CONCERNING THIS FRANCHISE.

We use the services of one or more franchise brokers or referral sources to assist us in selling our franchise. A franchise broker or referral source represents us, not you. We pay this person a fee for selling our franchise or referring you to us. You should be sure to do your own investigation of the franchise.
