The franchise is for the establishment and operation of a fitness business offering cardio kickboxing and strength and conditioning programs, including large classes, small-group sessions, and one-on-one training programs (each, an "Omni Fight Club" or "Club").

The total investment necessary to begin operation of an Omni Fight $\text{Club}^{(\mathbb{R})}$ franchise ranges from \$134,700 to \$617,000 (See Item 7). This includes \$44,125 to \$161,375 that must be paid to us and/or our affiliate. If you sign an area development agreement ("Development Agreement"), you will also pay a development fee equal to 100% of the initial franchise fee for the first Omni Fight Club to be developed under the Development Agreement plus 50% of the initial franchise fee for each additional Omni Fight Club to be developed under the Development Agreement. The portion of the development fee allocated to each Omni Fight Club (which is \$30,000 for your first Omni Fight Club and \$15,000 for each subsequent Omni Fight Club) will be credited against the initial franchise fee due for that Omni Fight Club (See Item 5).

This Disclosure Document summarizes certain provisions of your Franchise Agreement and Development Agreement and other information in plain English. Read this Disclosure Document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this Disclosure Document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. Note, however, that no governmental agency has verified the information contained in this document.
