The total investment necessary for a conversion franchise is a range of \$79,267 to \$358,070. This includes a range of \$43,000 to \$150,500 of Initial Fees that must be paid to the franchisor or affiliate. The total investment necessary for a start-up franchise is a range of \$246,665 to \$707,820. This includes a range of \$43,000 to \$150,500 of Initial Fees that must be paid to the franchisor or affiliate.

- 1. THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT REQUIRES YOU TO RESOLVE DISPUTES WITH US BY LITIGATION OR, IN CERTAIN SITUATIONS, MEDIATION. ALL LITIGATION AND MEDIATION SHALL BE CONDUCTED ONLY IN THE STATE WHERE OUR PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS IS LOCATED, CURRENTLY SARASOTA, FLORIDA. OUT OF STATE LITIGATION OR MEDIATION MAY FORCE YOU TO ACCEPT A LESS FAVORABLE SETTLEMENT FOR DISPUTES. IT MAY ALSO COST YOU MORE TO SUE OR MEDIATE WITH US IN FLORIDA (OR ANOTHER STATE) THAN IN YOUR OWN HOME STATE.
- 2. THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT STATES THAT THE LAW OF THE STATE WHERE OUR PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS IS LOCATED (CURRENTLY SARASOTA, FLORIDA) GOVERNS THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT, AND THIS LAW MAY NOT PROVIDE THE SAME PROTECTION AND BENEFITS AS LOCAL LAW. YOU MAY WANT TO COMPARE THESE LAWS.
- 3. YOU MUST PAY US A MINIMUM MONTHLY FRANCHISE FEE OF \$1,500.00 OR \$15 PER 1,000 OF POPULATION EVEN IF THE FRANCHISE HAS NO REVENUE.
- 4. YOUR FAILURE TO MEET AND MAINTAIN THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT, INCLUDING MINIMUM SALES PERFORMANCE STANDARDS OF \$5,000 PER 1,000 OF POPULATION PER ANNUM WITHIN THREE YEARS OF THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT MAY RESULT IN THE LOSS OF YOUR EXCLUSIVE RIGHTS IN YOUR TERRITORY.
- 5. SPOUSE(S) OF FRANCHISE OWNERS MAY BE REQUIRED TO EXECUTE A PERSONAL GUARANTY MAKING SUCH SPOUSE(S) JOINTLY AND SEVERALLY LIABLE FOR ALL OBLIGATIONS OF THE FRANCHISEE WHETHER OR NOT SUCH SPOUSE(S) IS/ARE INVOLVED IN THE OPERATION OF THE FRANCHISE BUSINESS. THIS REQUIREMENT PLACES THE PERSONAL ASSETS OF THE FRANCHISE OWNER(S) AND SPOUSE(S) AT RISK.
- 6. THERE MAY BE OTHER RISKS CONCERNING THIS FRANCHISE.
