The franchise offered is for the establishment and operation of a business offering quick and creative party planning for corporate events, social events, and kids' parties, including customized parties that include beverage parties, catered services, dessert parties, holiday parties, ice cream parties, theme parties and more

One Hour Parties offers two franchise options Tier 1 is a full service party planning option that includes beverage parties, catered services, dessert parties, holiday parties, ice cream parties, theme parties and more Or, Tier 2, which is a seasonal party planning option and is focused on one category of service, ice cream parties

The total investment necessary to begin operations of a One Hour Parties franchise (Tier 1) is \$44,500 to \$70,600. This includes \$30,100 to \$30,150 that must be paid to the franchisor or affiliate. The total investment necessary to begin operations of a One Hour Parties franchise (Tier 2) is 31,000 to \$57,100. This includes \$16,600 to \$16,650 that must be paid to the franchisor or affiliate.

This Disclosure Document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English Read this Disclosure Document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this Disclosure Document at least 14 calendar-days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale.
