The franchise offered is for the operation of a business that provides pick-up and drop-off service for dry-cleaned or laundered items, tailored goods and shoe repairs under the name "OneClick Cleaners®". We offer franchises for one pick-up/drop-off online franchise, where the actual dry cleaning is outsourced locally.

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a OneClick Cleaners franchised business is \$53,000 to \$70,000. This includes \$39,000 that must be paid to the franchisor.

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive the disclosure document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to the franchisor in connection with the proposed franchise sale. **Note, however, that no government agency has verified the information contained in this document.**
