The franchisee will operate an entertainment business under the name “Pump It Up” that features super-sized branded equipment, imagination-based games, merchandise, food and services (“Pump It Up Business”)

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a new Pump It Up Business ranges from **\$371,250 to \$784,500**. This includes **\$65,000 to \$70,000** that must be paid to us or our affiliates. The total investment necessary to begin operation of an existing Pump It Up Franchised Business ranges from **\$2,500 to \$112,690** not including the purchase price for the existing Pump It Up Franchised Business. This includes **\$0 to \$13,190** that must be paid to us or our affiliates.

This Disclosure Document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this Disclosure Document and all accompanying agreements carefully.
