As a Red Brick Pizza master developer you will offer retail restaurants in a defined territory featuring the on and off premise sale of a variety of different, high quality, Fire-Roasted Gourmet pizzas, other foods and beverages, and related products. The total investments necessary for you to begin operating a master developer franchisee ranges from \$123,500 to\$1,741,000, and for each unit franchise or subfranchise ranges from \$150,000 to \$499,000.

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 business days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to RBPW or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. Note, however, that no government agency has verified the information contained in this document.
