The franchise offered is for the operation of a franchised RENTERS WAREHOUSE® business ("Business") that provides property management and tenant placement services to owners and landlords of single family residences, condominiums, townhomes and apartments ("Property Management and Tenant Placement Services"). The total investment necessary to begin operation of a RENTERS WAREHOUSE® Business is \$41,969 to \$121,655. This includes \$16,138 to \$51,138 that must be paid to the franchisor or its affiliates.

This Disclosure Document summarizes certain provisions of your Franchise Agreement and other information in plain English. Read this Disclosure Document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this Disclosure Document at least 14 calendar-days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the Franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. Note, however, that no governmental agency has verified the information contained in this document.
