The franchisee will operate an automotive refinishing business under the name RestorFX offering wholesale and retail automotive restoration services.

The total initial investment necessary to begin operation of the a RestorFX Dedicated Center business ranges from \$128,900 to \$273,900. This includes \$64,000 that must be paid to us or an affiliate. The total initial investment necessary to begin operation of the a RestorFX Add-On Center business ranges from \$27,550 to \$49,800. This includes \$25,000 that must be paid to us or an affiliate.

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive the disclosure document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. **Note, however, that no government agency has verified the information contained in this document.**
