The franchisee will operate a retail store that sells nutritional and dietary supplements under the business trade name Rexius Nutrition.

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a Rexius Nutrition franchise ranges from \$64,775 to \$109,025. This includes an initial franchise fee of \$25,000 that must be paid to the franchisor. The total investment necessary to begin operation of a converted Rexius Nutrition franchise ranges from \$18,575 to \$47,125. This includes a conversion franchise fee for existing nutrition stores of \$10,000 that must be paid to the franchisor.

This Franchise Disclosure Document summarizes certain provisions of your Franchise Agreement and other information in plain English. Read this Disclosure Document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this Disclosure Document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. **Note, however, that no governmental agency has verified the information contained in this document.**

Please consider the following RISK FACTORS before you buy this franchise:

1. THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT REQUIRES YOU TO RESOLVE DISPUTES WITH US BY ARBITRATION AND ONLY IN ARIZONA. OUT OF STATE ARBITRATION MAY FORCE YOU TO ACCEPT A LESS FAVORABLE SETTLEMENT FOR DISPUTES. IT MAY ALSO COST YOU MORE TO ARBITRATE WITH US IN ARIZONA THAN IN YOUR OWN STATE.
2. THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT REQUIRES THAT ARIZONA LAW GOVERNS THE AGREEMENT, AND THIS LAW MAY NOT PROVIDE THE SAME PROTECTIONS AND BENEFITS AS LOCAL LAW. YOU MAY WANT TO COMPARE THESE LAWS.

YOUR SPOUSE AND THE SPOUSES OF FRANCHISE OWNERS, PARTNERS, MEMBERS, OFFICERS, AGENTS, DIRECTORS, AND TRUSTEES, MUST SIGN A PERSONAL GUARANTY MAKING THEM JOINTLY AND SEVERALLY LIABLE FOR ALL DEBTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF THE FRANCHISE WHETHER OR NOT THEY ARE INVOLVED IN THE OPERATION OF THE FRANCHISE BUSINESS. THIS REQUIREMENT PLACES ALL THE PERSONAL ASSETS OF YOU, YOUR SPOUSE AND YOUR OWNERS AT RISK.
4. THERE MAY BE OTHER RISKS CONCERNING THIS FRANCHISE.

We pay this person a fee for selling our franchise or referring you to us. You should make sure to do your own investigation of the franchise.
