Savory Spice Shop businesses offer a variety of seasonings and spices, original blends, extracts, sauces, spice ware and gift sets and service in a high end retail environment under the trademark Savory Spice Shop and related trademarks

The total investment necessary to begin operation of our standard Savory Spice Shop franchise is between \$184,886 and \$397,153, including between \$46,675 and \$154,000, that must be paid to the franchisor. We also offer Savory Spice Shop franchises that operate in larger retail spaces with expanded storage. The total investment necessary to begin operation of a larger Savory Spice Shop is between \$212,511 and \$440,653 including between \$57,300 and \$166,500, that must be paid to the franchisor. We also offer to those franchisees that qualify the right to operate a Savory Spice Stop franchise which operates in a smaller retail space and offers a limited selection of Savory Spice Shop products under the Savory Spice Stop name. The total investment necessary to begin operation of a Savory Spice Stop franchise is between \$139,511 and \$329,153, including between \$33,300 and \$136,500, that must be paid to the franchisor.

The disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your Franchise Agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least fourteen (14) calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. **Note, however, that no governmental agency has verified the information contained in this document.**
