The Franchisee (“Distributor”) will distribute bakery products that it purchases from the franchisor.

The total initial investment necessary to begin operation of the Schmidt Baking Distribution franchised business ranges from \$38,244 to \$247,738. This includes \$36,538 to \$178,853 that must be paid to the Franchisor and its affiliates.

This Disclosure Document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this Disclosure Document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this Disclosure Document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. **Note, however, that no government agency has verified the information contained in this document.**
