You will operate an indoor, tropical-themed party, entertainment, fitness and recreational facility for children and their families, using the "Scooter's Jungle" system and trademarks (a "Jungle").

The total estimated initial investment necessary to begin operation of a "Scooter's Jungle" facility ranges from \$591,950 to \$871,350 (see Item 7). This includes the initial fee of \$45,000 that must be paid to us. If your franchise business is, or includes, a Multi-Use Room, the Initial Investment required will be approximately \$100,000 more than the range provided above.

If you sign a Multi-unit Addendum, you will enter into three franchise agreements but the initial fee due under the second franchise agreement is reduced to \$35,000 and under the third franchise agreement is reduced to \$25,000.

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar-days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. Note, however, that no governmental agency has verified the information contained in this document.
