InFrasys, Inc. offers franchises for the production of pavement sealers and the sale of pavement maintenance products and equipment. You are granted the right to use the Mark “SEALMASTER.”

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a franchised business is \$579,800 to \$924,500. This includes \$35,000 that must be paid to us. If you are a conversion franchisee, the total investment necessary to begin operation of a franchised business is \$64,300 to \$651,000. This includes \$25,000 that must be paid to us.

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. **Note, however, that no government agency has verified the information contained in this document.**

2. THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT STATES THAT OHIO LAW GOVERNS THE AGREEMENT, AND THIS LAW MAY NOT PROVIDE THE SAME PROTECTIONS AND BENEFITS AS LOCAL LAW. YOU MAY WANT TO COMPARE THESE LAWS.
