The franchise offered is for the right to own and operate a "Single Cylinder Repair" business which sells and services a variety of power equipment, including chain saws, trimmers, lawn mowers, generators and other equipment for commercial and residential customers.

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a "Single Cylinder Repair" franchise is from \$296,000to \$442,000. This includes \$25,000 that must be paid to the franchisor and/or its affiliate.
