The franchisee will operate a Sky Zone Indoor Trampoline Park that offers patented all trampoline walled Playing Fields to be used for sports, fitness and recreational activities

The total investment necessary to begin operations of a Sky Zone franchised business is from \$1,232,131 to \$2,968,000, depending on the size of your park. This includes \$393,000 to \$970,000 that must be paid to the franchisor and/or its affiliates, as applicable. If you want to obtain the right to develop multiple Sky Zone Indoor Trampoline Parks within a particular geographic area, you will pay all initial franchise fees to us in a lump sum.

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar-days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. **Note, however, that no governmental agency has verified the information contained in this document.**
