Soccer Shots Franchising, LLC offers franchises for a youth soccer education program marketed to children ages 2-8 primarily through daycare centers, preschools, parks, and other community programs.

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a Soccer Shots franchise is \$41,034 - \$53,950. This includes a \$34,500 Initial Franchise Fee plus up to \$1,550 that must be paid to the franchisor or an affiliate.

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. Note, however, that no governmental agency has verified the information contained in this document.

The terms of your contract will govern your franchise relationship. Don't rely on the disclosure document alone to understand your contract. Read all of your contract carefully. Show your contract and this disclosure document to an advisor, like a lawyer or an accountant.

Buying a franchise is a complex investment. The information in this disclosure document can help you make up your mind. BEFORE YOU BUY, CONSIDER WHAT RIGHTS YOU HAVE TO RENEW YOUR FRANCHISE, IF ANY, AND WHAT TERMS YOU MIGHT HAVE TO ACCEPT IN ORDER TO RENEW.

Please consider the following RISK FACTORS before you buy this franchise:

- 1. THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT STATES THAT PENNSYLVANIA LAW GOVERNS THE AGREEMENT, AND THIS LAW MAY NOT PROVIDE THE SAME PROTECTIONS AND BENEFITS AS LOCAL LAW. YOU MAY WANT TO COMPARE THESE LAWS.
- 2. THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT REQUIRES YOU TO RESOLVE DISPUTES WITH US BY MEDIATION, ARBITRATION AND IN CERTAIN CASES, LITIGATION, ONLY IN PENNSYLVANIA, EXCEPT AS DESCRIBED IN THE STATE ADDENDA. OUT OF STATE MEDIATION, ARBITRATION OR LITIGATION MAY FORCE YOU TO ACCEPT A LESS FAVORABLE SETTLEMENT FOR DISPUTES. IT MAY ALSO COST MORE TO MEDIATE, ARBITRATE OR LITIGATE WITH SOCCER SHOTS IN PENNSYLVANIA THAN IN YOUR STATE.
- 3. PURSUANT TO FEDERAL AND STATE LAW, THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT REQUIRES YOU TO CONSENT TO, AND CONDUCT ON ALL EMPLOYEES, A BACKGROUND CHECK, INCLUDING A CRIMINAL HISTORY, FOR PURPOSES OF WORKING IN A DAYCARE CENTER OR PRESCHOOL.
- 4. FAILURE TO ACHIEVE THE MINIMUM PERFORMANCE STANDARD CAN RESULT IN THE TERMINATION OF THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT OR A REDUCTION IN THE SIZE OF YOUR TERRITORY.
- 5. THERE MAY BE OTHER RISKS CONCERNING THIS FRANCHISE.

We may use the services of one or more FRANCHISE BROKERS or referral sources to assist us in selling our franchise. A franchise broker or referral source represents us, not you. We pay this person or entity a fee for selling our franchise or referring you to us. You should be sure to do your own investigation of the franchise.
