Squeeze Franchising Corporation is offering franchises for the right to operate a quick service restaurant offering smoothies, fresh fruit juices, yogurt parfaits, baked goods, protein bars and other nutritional products under the service mark "SQUEEZE." We also grant to qualified persons, under our Area Director Agreement, the right to solicit and refer to us qualified prospective franchisees and to provide ongoing supervision to our franchisees located in a particular geographic area, in exchange for a fee and continuing commissions.

The initial franchise fee is \$25,000 for your first traditional SQUEEZE Store. The estimated initial investment required for your first traditional SQUEEZE Store ranges from \$158,000 to \$244,000. When an Area Director Agreement is signed, the Area Director must pay a fee based on the following formula: the total of the area population multiplied by \$.03, plus a training fee of \$5,000 for the Area Director training program. The estimated initial investment required for an Area Director business, exclusive of any store related costs, ranges from \$66,125 to \$429,500. See Items 5 and 7.

Risk Factors:

- 1. THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT AND AREA DIRECTOR AGREEMENT PERMIT THE FRANCHISEE TO ARBITRATE WITH US ONLY IN COLORADO. OUT OF STATE ARBITRATION MAY FORCE YOU TO ACCEPT A LESS FAVORABLE SETTLEMENT. IT MAY ALSO COST YOU MORE TO ARBITRATE WITH US IN COLORADO THAN IN YOUR HOME STATE.
- THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT AND AREA DIRECTOR AGREEMENT STATE 2. THAT COLORADO LAW GOVERNS THE AGREEMENT, AND THIS LAW MAY NOT PROVIDE THE SAME PROTECTIONS AND BENEFITS AS LOCAL LAW. YOU MAY WANT TO COMPARE THESE LAWS.
- THE FRANCHISOR WAS FORMED ON DECEMBER 31, 2003 AND HAS A LIMITED 3. **OPERATING HISTORY AND RECORD OF PERFORMANCE.**
