If you already own a TapSnap[™] Franchise and are entering into a Franchise Agreement for an additional franchise, the Initial Franchise Fee and the Equipment Purchase Fee that you must pay us for your second or more franchise is the same, or may vary based upon the quantity of equipment purchased.

This Disclosure Document summarizes certain provisions of your Franchise Agreement and other information in plain English. Read this Disclosure Document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this Disclosure Document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. **Note, however, that no governmental agency has verified the information contained in this document.**
