The franchise offered is for the operation of a culinary entertainment and educational experience for kids and families under the name "Taste Buds Kitchen" and using the franchisor's proprietary methods, techniques, trade dress, trademarks and logos.

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a single Taste Buds Kitchen franchise is from \$187,300 to \$306,850. This includes from \$40,600 to \$45,100 that must be paid to the franchisor.

We also offer the opportunity for a franchisee to sign an Area Development Agreement that will allow development of additional franchises in a defined area. Under an Area Development Agreement the franchisee will not pay the initial franchise fee with the opening of each individual franchise, but will instead pay us a Development Fee for the entire package in accordance with the number of franchises to be developed. The fee for 2 franchises is \$60,000; the fee for 3 franchises is \$75,000; and the fee for 5 franchises is \$100,000. If we agree to offer you more than five franchises there will be an additional initial franchise fee of \$20,000 for each additional franchise to be developed.

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive the disclosure document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. **Note, however, that no government agency has verified the information contained in this document.**
