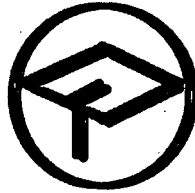

We are **TeachPro, Inc.**, an Oklahoma corporation. We offer and promote franchises in a network of in-home and in-school tutoring classes in reading and math for students in grades pre-kindergarten through 12. You must first purchase an In-home franchise before being able to obtain the right to offer our in-school programs.

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a TeachPro **In-home** franchise is **\$12,750** to **\$47,400**. The total investment necessary to begin operation of a TeachPro **In-School** franchise is **\$500** to **\$9,650**. This estimate is only approximate. This includes the Initial Franchise Fee that must be paid to us that ranges from **\$5,000** to **\$15,000** and a Curriculum Package for **\$1,250 plus freight (Approx. \$400)**. Your initial investment and initial fees are more fully described in Items 5, 6 and 7 of this Disclosure Document.

Information comparing franchisors is available. Call the state administrators, listed in Exhibit E, or your public library for sources of information.

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar-days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. **Note, however, that no governmental agency has verified the information contained in this document.**

THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT REQUIRES YOU TO RESOLVE DISPUTES WITH US BY MEDIATION AND LITIGATION ONLY IN OKLAHOMA. OUT-OF-STATE LITIGATION AND MEDIATION MAY FORCE YOU TO ACCEPT A LESS FAVORABLE SETTLEMENT FOR DISPUTES. IT MAY ALSO COST YOU MORE TO SUE OR MEDIATE WITH US IN OKLAHOMA THAN IN YOUR OWN STATE.

THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT STATES THAT OKLAHOMA LAW GOVERNS THE AGREEMENT, AND THIS LAW MAY NOT PROVIDE THE SAME PROTECTIONS AND BENEFITS AS LOCAL LAW. YOU MAY WANT TO COMPARE THESE LAWS.

WE ARE A DEVELOPMENT STAGE COMPANY WITH NO OPERATING HISTORY TO ASSIST A PROSPECTIVE FRANCHISEE IN DECIDING TO MAKE THIS INVESTMENT. WE HAVE LIMITED WORKING CAPITAL, WHICH POTENTIALLY WILL NOT BE ADEQUATE TO FUND OUR PRE-OPENING OBLIGATIONS TO EACH FRANCHISEE

THERE MAY BE OTHER RISKS CONCERNING THIS FRANCHISE.
