As a franchisee, you will organize and operate races, runs and walks.

There are two franchises offered in this disclosure document: the Dirty Dash® franchise and the Color Me Rad<sup>TM</sup> franchise. The franchise agreement is the same for both franchises except the initial fees (see Items 5 and 7) and some required purchases (see Item 8). The total investment necessary to begin operation of a Dirty Dash® franchise is between \$75,600 and \$123,500. This includes the \$36,000 paid to the franchise or affiliate. The total investment necessary to begin operation of a Color Me Rad<sup>TM</sup> franchise is between \$67,600 and \$109,000. This includes the \$30,000 paid to the franchisor or affiliate. There is a \$1,000 up-front fee to obtain the rights for a multi-unit development territory outside of the United States and Canada.

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar-days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate regarding the proposed franchise sale. Note, however, that no governmental agency has verified the information contained in this document.
