The franchises offered are for the operation of a Unit Franchise or an Area Development Business. Unit Franchises operate individual THE SPICE & TEA EXCHANGE® Stores. Area Development franchises develops and operates multiple THE SPICE & TEA EXCHANGE® Stores.

The total initial investment necessary to begin operation of a Unit Franchise under the TSTE Managed Build-Out Option ranges from \$159,800,164,100 to \$274,400.248,400. This includes \$149,900 to \$240,900,169,900 plus \$10,000 for each additional THE SPICE & TEA EXCHANGE® Store that you agree to develop that must be paid to the franchisor or affiliates. The total initial investment necessary to begin an-Area-Development Business-of 2-to-5-THE-SPICE-&-TEA-EXCHANGE® Stores ranges from \$479,800-to \$324,400 for the Area Development-Program (besed-on-2-to-5-Unit-Franchises and including the cost-of-oneoperation of a Unit Franchise under the Build-Out Manual Option ranges from \$141,600 to \$268,400. This includes \$99,900 to \$109,900 plus \$10,000 for each additional THE SPICE & TEA EXCHANGE® Store). This includes \$169,900 to \$262,400, you agree to develop that must be paid to the franchisor or-its affiliates.
