The franchisee will operate a retail food restaurant operating under the name “Tony Luke’s.” The total investment necessary to begin operation of a franchised business is from \$170,000 to \$396,000. This includes an initial franchise fee of \$35,000 that must be paid to the franchisor or affiliate.

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your Franchise Agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment, to the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. **Note, however, that no government agency has verified the information contained in this document.**
