The "Touching Hearts" franchise is for the right to use Touching Hearts, Inc.'s trademarks and confidential proprietary information to operate a business that provides in-home non-medical and companion services for seniors and persons with disabilities.

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a "Touching Hearts" franchise ranges from \$48,400 to \$69,100. This includes \$34,500 that must be paid to the franchisor as the initial franchise fee.

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the franchise sale. **Note, however, that no governmental agency has verified the information contained in this document**.

The terms of your contract will govern your franchise relationship. Do not rely on the disclosure document alone to understand your contract. Read all of your contract carefully. Show your contract and this disclosure document to an advisor, like a lawyer or an accountant.

Buying a franchise is a complex investment. BEFORE YOU BUY, CONSIDER WHAT RIGHTS YOU HAVE TO RENEW YOUR FRANCHISE, IF ANY, AND WHAT TERMS YOU MIGHT HAVE TO ACCEPT IN ORDER TO RENEW.

Please consider the following RISK FACTORS before you buy this franchise:

- 1. THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT REQUIRES YOU TO RESOLVE DISPUTES WITH US BY ARBITRATION ONLY IN MINNESOTA. OUT-OF-STATE ARBITRATION MAY FORCE YOU TO ACCEPT A LESS FAVORABLE SETTLEMENT FOR DISPUTES. IT MAY ALSO COST YOU MORE TO ARBITRATE WITH US IN MINNESOTA THAN IN YOUR OWN STATE.
- 2. THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT STATES THAT MINNESOTA LAW GOVERNS THE AGREEMENT, AND THIS LAW MAY NOT PROVIDE THE SAME PROTECTIONS AND BENEFITS AS LOCAL LAW. YOU MAY WANT TO COMPARE THESE LAWS.
- 3. WE MAY REDUCE THE SIZE OF YOUR TERRITORY, TERMINATE YOUR FRANCHISE AGREEMENT, AND/OR TAKE OTHER ACTIONS AS WE DEEM APPROPRIATE OR NECESSARY IF YOU FAIL TO MAINTAIN STATED SALES LEVELS.
- 4. THERE MAY BE OTHER RISKS CONCERNING THIS FRANCHISE.
