4 THE FRANCHISOR'S CORPORATE PARENT HAS OVER 15 YEARS OF EXPERIENCE OPENING AND OPERATING BUCKHORN GRILL RESTAURANTS IN NORTHERN CALIFORNIA. THE FRANCHISOR IS A SIX-YEAR OLD ENTITY AND DOES NOT HAVE A LONG OPERATING HISTORY.
