As a franchisee you will operate a TruFusion wellness center which will offer yoga pilates TruX barre aerial yoga kettleball battle ropes and bootcamp classes yoga teacher training programs, nutritional works shops and other related programs and activities The total estimated investment necessary to begin the operation of a TruFusion wellness center ranges from \$472 427 to \$900 000 This includes \$50 000 that must be paid to the franchisor

We also offer a Multi-Unit Development Agreement for the development of at least three TruFusion wellness centers The estimated initial investment to operate as a Multi-Unit Developer will vary depending on the number of businesses to be developed If you sign the Multi-Unit Development Agreement to develop 3-4 TruFusion wellness centers you will pay a Development Fee equal to \$37 500 multiplied by the total number of wellness centers to be developed in your development area If you sign the Multi-Unit Development Agreement to develop 5 or more TruFusion wellness centers you will pay a Development Fee equal to \$30 000 multiplied by the total number of wellness centers to be developed in your development area
