We offer to qualified individuals and entities the opportunity to become our Area Representative within a specific geographical area. An Area Representative will act as our agent to solicit new franchisees and provide pre-opening and ongoing support to TruFusion franchisees in a defined geographical area. An Area Representative will pay an Initial Fee that will be negotiated between us. The total investment necessary to begin operation as an Area Representative is \$310,500 - \$571,200. This includes between \$300,000 to \$550,000 that must be paid to the franchisor and/or its affiliate.

This Disclosure Document summarizes certain provisions of your area representative agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. Note, however, that no governmental agency has verified the information contained in this document.

OUT-OF-STATE MEDIATION, ARBITRATION OR LITIGATION MAY FORCE YOU TO ACCEPT A LESS FAVORABLE SETTLEMENT FOR DISPUTES. IT MAY ALSO COST YOU MORE TO MEDIATE, ARBITRATE OR LITIGATE WITH US IN NEVADA THAN IT MAY COST IN YOUR OWN STATE OR AREA.
