The Franchise offered is for the operation of a mobile alloy wheel repair business that provides services to repair and restore alloy wheels for all types of vehicles. This is a service-oriented business performing onsite wheel repair and refurbishing services using proprietary processes and specialized equipment, under the name "Trundle™". The Initial Franchise Fee is \$10,000 with rights to operate a Trundle™ business. Additional franchises may be available for those franchisees who have bought at least one franchise, at a reduced fee of \$5,000 per franchise. The total investment necessary to begin operation of a Trundle™ franchise ranges from \$19,700 to \$39,250 which will depend on a number of factors which are further discussed in Item 7. These figures include the Initial Franchise Fee of \$10,000 (as discussed in Item 5) that must be paid to the Franchisor or its affiliate

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read the disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or any affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. Note, however, no governmental agency has verified the information contained in this document.

- 6) THE FRANCHISEE'S SPOUSE MUST SIGN A PERSONAL GUARANTY MAKING SUCH SPOUSE JOINTLY AND SEVERALLY LIABLE FOR THE OBLIGATIONS UNDER THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT WHICH ALSO PLACES THE SPOUSE'S PERSONAL ASSETS
