We offer franchises for "Upward Stars" Christian amateur athletic sports programs operated pursuant to our system and which include the development of high performance "Upward Stars" amateur athletic teams, and offering of developmental programs, clinics, tournaments and related activities and events that we designate or approve ("Authorized Programs")

Our "Certified Leader" franchise is offered to new franchisees with no prior experience owning or operating an "Upward Stars' franchise. Our "Affiliate" franchise is offered to experienced Certified Leaders that have satisfied certain performance thresholds. As a Certified Leader franchisee you will offer Authorized Programs in a defined geographic area for either basketball or volleyball, and you will develop "Upward Stars' performance teams in one sport of either basketball or volleyball. As an Affiliate franchisee, you will offer Authorized Programs in multiple sports (basketball, volleyball, soccer and baseball), develop additional. Upward Stars' performance teams across multiple sports and age levels, and may sponsor tournaments.

The total estimated initial investment necessary to begin operation of an "Upward Stars" Certified Leader franchise ranges from \$6,400 00 to \$17 000 (see Item 7) This includes \$1,500 00 that must be paid to the franchisor or affiliate (see Item 5) The total estimated initial investment necessary to begin operation of an "Upward Stars" Affiliate franchise ranges from \$13,000 00 to \$23 000 00 (see Item 7) This includes \$5,000 00 that must be paid to the franchisor or affiliate (see Item 5)

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar-days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale.
