The franchise described is known as “US Tax Recovery Partners”®. US Tax Recovery Partners, LLC is involved in the tax recovery service business and identifies sales and use tax overpayments made by manufacturing companies. US Tax Recovery Partners, LLC specializes in identifying, filing for and recovering these overpayments from State and local governments.

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a US Tax Recovery Partners Single Unit franchised business is \$54,050 - \$137,500. This includes \$20,000 for the initial Franchise Fee and \$14,750 for a Protected Territory within a Metropolitan or Micropolitan Statistical Area Territory that must be paid to the Franchisor.

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. **Note however, that no governmental agency has verified the information contained in this document.**

2. THE US TAX RECOVERY PARTNERS FRANCHISE AGREEMENT STATES THAT TEXAS LAW GOVERNS THE AGREEMENT, AND THIS LAW MAY NOT PROVIDE THE SAME PROTECTIONS AND BENEFITS AS LOCAL LAW. YOU MAY WANT TO COMPARE THESE LAWS.

3. THERE MAY BE OTHER RISKS CONCERNING THIS FRANCHISE.
