<u>Single WRTS Kid's Gym Program</u> Under this program, you will sign a Franchise Agreement for a single We Rock The Spectrum Kid's Gym. The total investment necessary to begin operation of a We Rock The Spectrum Kid's Gym is approximately \$98,900 to \$114,700, which includes \$41,500 that must be paid to us or our affiliate

<u>Area Development Program</u> Under this program, you will agree to operate 2 – 3 WRTS Kid's Gyms in a defined geographic area within a specified period of time. The total investment necessary to begin operation of a multiple development franchise for 2 - 3 WRTS Kid's Gyms is approximately \$119,900 to \$148,700 per WRTS Kid's Gym, which includes \$61,500 to \$71,500 that must be paid to us or our affiliate

This Disclosure Document summarizes certain provisions of your Franchise Agreement and other information in plain English Read the Disclosure Document and all accompanying agreements carefully.
